Oak Park Our Whole Lives (OP-OWL) offers training in the nationally recognized Our Whole Lives comprehensive sexuality curriculum in exchange for your commitment to:

- Attend a 2.5-day training in OWL facilitation, typically in summer/fall
- Participate in a thorough background check
- Facilitate one session of developmentally appropriate classes for kids in K-1st, 4th& 5th, or 7th-9th grades, starting in fall or winter each year. Time commitments vary by age group; see schedules on our web page for current dates and times. www.opowl.org

OP-OWL pays for the training (including mileage and lodging) and a copy of the OWL curriculum for all facilitators. Children of facilitators are guaranteed spots in the OP-OWL programs free of charge.

Good facilitator candidates are:

- Committed to values-based, comprehensive sexuality education.
- Comfortable with their own sexuality.
- Comfortable with the specific age group they plan to facilitate and its developmental needs.
- Anti-bias aware and willing to continue educating themselves.
- Advocates for sexual health and safety.
- Dedicated team members and facilitators.
